

Many of us have *Fond Memories of Sister Mary Concepta, RSM* as our teacher and Head of the "Secretarial Department and Placement Bureau". A typewritten note which included a sentence in shorthand, given by her to the 1949 class, listed points for building a strong Christian character:

- 8. A person of character is clean in thought, word, and deed.
